A Good Chance

Royal Roads university (RRU) is a public university that was established by the government of British Columbia (BC), Canada in 1995. It is located in the city of Victoria, well known for its temperate climate and beautiful West Coast setting and is the capital city of the province of BC. RRU is a good university for studying and if you plan to study there, I have some details about RRU for you.

When you graduate from BCIT, you have three alternatives if you want to study at RRU. First, you can get your diploma at BCIT, and then get your degree in a one-year program at RRU. Second, you can use BCIT part time studies towards RRU a two years degree program. Third, you can study on-line for two years at RRU. This sounds like good option because you can study anywhere and anytime. These are three options that are good for international students.

In addition, the tuition fees for international students are quite cheap. If you want to study a Bachelor of Commerce in Entrepreneurial Management, the tuition fee is \$5,800 per year, so the total is \$11,600 if you choose the two-year option. If you want to study a Master of Business Administration, the tuition fee is \$16,000 per year, so the total is \$32,000 for two years. As you see, the tuition at RRU is not expensive compared to other universities.

RRU has many different programs, such as a Master of Business Administration, Bachelor of Commerce in Entrepreneurial Management, Master of Science in Environment, Bachelor of Science in Entrepreneurial Science, Master of Arts in Leadership & Training. These are very popular programs, I am sure that if you get a degree from RRU, you will have a good job anywhere you plan to live.

All in all, RRU is a good place to study. You can finish your degree quickly, save money, and have variety of programs to choose from. I recommend that you study there, and then you will have a good future.

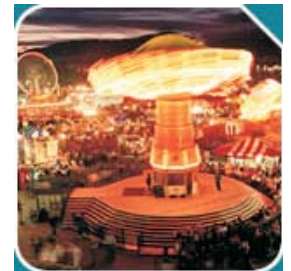

A movie rarely comes along, which is truly great by all means. M. Night Shyamalan's new summer hit movie 'Signs' is just that. Mel Gibson turns in a wonderful performance as Graham Hess, an ex-Catholic priest, who loses his faith after his wife dies. Now he lives with his brother Merrill (Joaquin Phoenix) on a farm in Philadelphia with his two children, Morgan (Rory Culkin) and Bo (Abigail Breslin). After finding crop circles in his cornfields, weird things start to happen all leading up to very good conclusion.

The acting in Signs itself makes it worthy of critical acclaim. Mel Gibson does possibly his best work since 'Brave Heart', and Joaquin Phoenix is excellent as a funny, but responsible brother to Graham. Rory Culkin, whose brother is Macaulay Culkin, acts well, especially in emotional scene. Abigail Breslin lights up the screen, one scene in particular with Gibson, when she asks why her father talks to her mother sometimes. Another great performance by all the actors is in one scene at dinner, in which they all have a bit of a feud. It's acting at it's best.

M. Night Shyamalan, who directed, wrote, produced, and acted in this movie is one of the best directors to emerge into the

film industry in years. What separates Shyamalan from other directors is that even if he wasn't paid, he'd still make movies, and his movie is genuine and very original. 'Signs' isn't about aliens attacking Earth, what crop circles come from or their purpose or anything you'd think. 'Signs' is about an ordinary man, who loses his faith, and then finds it again. That is what this movie is about. 'Signs' is not a horror movie about aliens attacking, or any real action scenes at all. We are presented with a man and his family, and what they would do. We don't want to see 'E.T', nor 'Independence Day', or such horror science fiction movies like 'Alien' and 'Predator'. Though most of those movies are great, we've seen it before, and that's what makes 'Signs' different from other alien films, and what makes us interested in it. 'Signs' isn't really about aliens. It's how a man finds his faith again in this situation. Shyamalan just took a subject he found interesting, popped in a family in the middle, and presented his brilliant message on screen.

The aliens, though I won't ruin anything, are done perfectly, not showing them fully on screen, until when you least expect it. One interesting part of this movie is in which a baby monitor accidentally

picks up aliens speaking in 'clicks,' which shows how we suspect they communicate between each other.

Unlike a lot of movies, 'Signs' also has an excellent ending. The message comes across, and you can easily realize that Shyamalan delivered what he wanted to be delivered. You should watch the movie, 'Signs', I promise that you will not feel down. And, it is much better not to see it alone even though it's not horror because it's going to scare you.

The History of Labour Day

Labour Day, the first Monday in September, is a creation of the labour movement and is dedicated to the social and economic achievements of North American workers. It constitutes a yearly national tribute to the contributions workers have made to the strength prosperity and well being of their country.

The first Labour Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, September 5, 1882 in New York City, in accordance with the plans of the Central Labour Union. The Central Labour Union held its second Labour Day holiday just a year later, on September 5, 1883, and in 1885 the Labour Day was celebrated in many industrial centers throughout many countries.

More than 100 years after, there is still some debate as to who first proposed the Labour Day for workers. Some records show that Peter J. McGuire, general secretary of the Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners and a cofounder of the American Federation of Labour, first suggested a day to celebrate labourers. However, many believe that Matthew Maguire, a machinist, found the holiday. Recent research seems to support the belief that Matthew Maguire proposed the holiday while serving as secretary of The Central Labour Union in New York in 1882.

The vital of labour added to the highest standard of living and the greatest production the world has ever known. It has brought us closer to the realization of our traditional ideas of economic and political democracy. It is appropriate, therefore, that the nation pays tribute on Labour Day to the creator of so much of the nation's strength, freedom and leadership--the North American Workers.

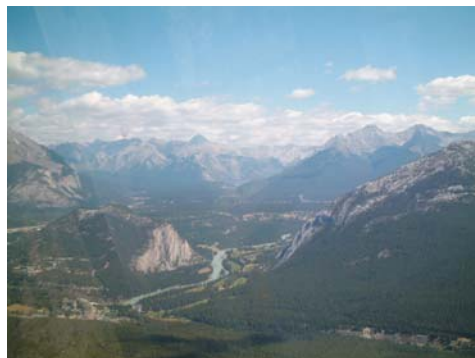
