## Let Your Computer Work for You!! By Tony Google

hy not let your computer help you to get high marks and save money! Getting higher marks and saving money is important for every International student. There are three good computer tools that can help us to do all the things that we need. Not only can these tools help us to get higher marks, but they are already in our computers!

#### **The First Tool**

Do you know how to produce good TV reports and oral presentations? If we can do our TV reports or presentations well, we will get higher marks. Microsoft Word is the best tool for our outlines, TV reports, and presentations. It not only can help us to do our reports but also can check our grammar and vocabulary.

An outline is the most important step for our reports or presentations. Microsoft Outline view can help us to do the outline well. It uses different levels of headings to represent different ideas. Using Outline view in Word can help teachers or students easily see the structure of their reports. To use Outline view, click on the view menu in Word and then choose Outline, and click Outline. If we want to return to the normal view, we can click the view menu in Word and then choose Normal.

When we finish our outline, the next step is writing our reports, which usually affects our marks. When we do our reports in Word, we might find some red underlines and green underlines show up. The red and green underlines indicate that our vocabulary spelling errors or grammar problems. If we want to do our reports very well, we have to correct our vocabulary and grammar mistakes. When we use Word to help us to do reports, we can use "spelling and grammar tools" to help us to check our vocabulary and grammar. To run the spelling and grammar checker automatically, we can click Tools menu in Word. On the Options, choose the "Spelling and Grammar" tab. The next step is selecting the "Check spelling as you type" and "Check grammar as you type". When we finish these steps, Word will help us to check our vocabulary and grammar.


#### The Second Tool

Managing our money is very important for International students. Does everyone know how to save money? Some people might say that they can buy something cheaper. In fact, this is not effective to save money, and the effect of saving money is to record money in books. Fortunately, we can use our computer to help us to save money. We can use Microsoft Excel to help us to save our money. If we can use Excel very well, we can write a program in Excel to help us to

save money; however, if we cannot write programs, we also can download a budget program form Microsoft website (http://officeupdate.microsoft.com/Template Gallery/redir.asp?TID=1136), and click the "Edit in Microsoft Excel". This program executes in Excel. We just enter money and expenditure to this program, and it will count how much money we have and expenditure.

#### The Third Tool

Now that we know how to use Word to help us to do good reports, the next step is finding information. The Internet is the best



place that we can find a lot of information. We can use some search engines to help us to find the information that we need. "Google" (<a href="http://www.google.com/">http://www.google.com/</a>) is the best search

engine in the Internet. There are some tips can help everyone to find information quickly.

"+" Searches - We can use "+" to join our phrases, such as KGC+language school. "-" Searches We can use "-" to exclude our phrases, such as KGC-language school. "OR" Searches We can use capital "OR" to include either phrase A or phrase B, such as KGC OR language school.

If you use "Google" to find some information, you might find some interesting things. If you find information that is more than one page, you will find that the middle of "Google" becomes longer. In addition, on Google's homepage, you might discover things different from other websites. Because November 11 is Canada's "Remembrance Day", the website of Google (http://www.google.ca) is different from before. In this website, you will find a poppy in the homepage of Google Canada.

In summary, these computer tools can help us to do our reports well. In fact, computer tools, such as Word, Excel, and Internet Explorer are already in our computers. If we can use these tools well, and add to our ideas, we will get higher marks and save a lot of money. Actually, Getting High Marks and Saving Money can be a piece of cake.

## A Cruel Game: Battle Royale





In 2001, Kinji Fuakasaku, who is a 70-year-old amiable director, brought us a movie named Battle Royale. Although this movie has a lot of violence, and the Japanese government had to restrict adolescents from watching this movie, personally, I thought this fantastic story was really worth reviewing.

The story of Battle Royale tells us about an Asian country that falls into a depression, and millions of people lose their jobs. School violence is out of control, and Students even attack teachers. Consequently, the government has to formulate cruel laws that create a system where the government randomly chooses a class of students from each school every year, and the students in this class must go to an island and kill each other until only one is left.

Director Fuakasaku attempts to express the importance of trust. At the beginning of the story, the students who join this cruel game appear united, because they have studied together for three years, and some of them have become good friends. However, when the game begins and two strange and dangerous students take part in the game, the trust is broken. Since some students expect to survive, they begin to murder each other. Others choose to kill themselves because they cannot trust each other. However, the power of only one person is limited and is not enough to allow a person to survive. Even if he or she can murder several people, a person who is stronger will kill him or her eventually. Consequently, all students who cannot trust each other are killed at the end of the story. For instance, a group of girls who stay at a lighthouse trust each other at the beginning, and even attempt to escape off this island. However, when one of these girls is poisoned, the trust crumbles. These girls who look graceful and beautiful become insane and cruel. Within only five minutes, all these girls are killed. Thoughout this cruel story, the

director criticizes adolescents for their selfish behaviour and dishonesty..

Fuakasaku also criticizes Japanese education system. Because of the economic depression, thousands of parents are unemployed, so they have to pay more attention to finding jobs rather than on how to educate their children. On the other hand, adolescents think that society ignores them, and their parents don't care for them. So some of them surfer from autism, and some of them become violent and selfish. However, schools also ignore the students' situation, and they only focus on how to allow students to enter universities rather than on how to live in the competitive society. Consequently, the students become more violent and cruel, and they even attack teachers. Some students consider that they are better and smarter than their teachers, and they even refuse to attend to school. Fuakasaku hopes that they must learn to respect their parents and teachers, or they will be forsaken.

Acknowledgment by Quentin Tarantino and John Woo who are famous directors is a key influence on the style of the movies. Fuakasaku decided to shoot a movie for adolescents, so Battle Roayle was generated. Although this movie is violent, personally, I think that Battle Royale is still a great movie.

bout 2000 years ago, people would put snuff into beautifully painted bottles, but over time, the use of snuff became unpopular. After that time, a lot of people started to draw pictures inside the bottles, and the bottles were painted and used as artwork. Nowadays, drawing inside porcelain bottles has become an important part of Chinese culture.

Inside-drawing usually consists of two materials: glass and crystal. The painter draws the picture inside the bottle using wood, willows and brushes. The painting will appear on the front inside part of the bottles. The painter sketches out lines thinner than hairs. The inside drawing artist draws the pictures with a kind of special thin-brush. Artists can draw the pictures inside the bottle wall through the Small mouth. Inside drawing art is now viewed as a very special art throughout the world.

The art on the bottles includes: flowers, birds, insects, fish, human beings, landscapes etc. The pictures look like they are painted on the outside, but they actually were painted inside the bottles.

If you want to buy inside drawing snuff





bottles, you can go to a Chinese shop at Metrotown. The name of the shop is Oriental Touch. The price of a snuff bottle is \$20--\$50, and the cost of a whole set of snuff bottles is \$200--\$300. As we know, inside drawing is the epitome of a splendid culture and the pride of our Chinese nation. From this art, we can see and learn about a very simple but colorful world. Personally, I have seen these beautiful bottles, and I believe they would make great gifts for any occasion.
